

## Bio Taryn G. Kryzda

Taryn Kryzda has been a life-long resident of south Florida, graduating from Jupiter High School in 1975. Taryn has a master's degree in public administration and a bachelor's degree in financial management. Currently, Taryn is the Village Manager for the Village of Indiantown. Prior to her current role, for 13 years Taryn was the County Administrator for Martin County, the longest tenure of a County Administrator in the County since the position was created in 1974. Taryn retired from Martin County after serving the residents for a total of 35 years. Taryn is an experienced public sector professional with a strong background in management and finance. Taryn is focused on getting the Village prepared for a wave of new development and business relocations. The Village was incorporated in December of 2017, still relatively new, with the potential for growth. Since Taryn's arrival at the Village in early 2023, there have been 810 residential units approved and almost 200,000 square feet of additional industrial or commercial buildings planned within Village boundaries. With a current population of roughly 6500 and being a historically disadvantaged designated rural community, the new development will begin to change the Village's character and potential. The horizon for the Village has a few major challenges which Taryn sees as opportunities and looks forward to what the future brings.
